CHRISTMAS PROGRAM/CONCERT ~ TONIGHT @ 7:00

Band students should report to Miss Stout's classroom at 6:30 to warm up. All other students should be here between 6:40-6:45. Pre-Kindergarten classes should report to their classroom while the academy music and chorus class should go to the music room.

This will be a combined program for the CDC Pre-Kindergarten classes and the academy and will be held in the sanctuary. The Pre-K classes will share the first section of the program with the lower elementary grades. It will be 20 to 25 minutes in length, followed by an intermission in which Pre-K parents and children may leave if they choose. After the intermission, the elementary students and the middle and high school chorus and band will perform for the remainder of the program. Private lesson students will perform pieces interspersed throughout the evening. The entire concert (both sections) should be about 1 hour and 15 minutes.

Academy parents of middle and high school students are requested to sit in the balcony during the first part of the program or "run an errand" after dropping off your kids and come back at 7:20 to be seated during the intermission. Seating will be very crowded prior to the intermission. Student participation is mandatory.

Dress Code for academy students is as follows: Dress clothes with Christmas colors - No jeans, t-shirts, or tennis shoes. Skirts and dresses must be dress code length. Dress slacks are permissible for girls as well.


