Dress code will be nice Sunday dress (same as before – no jeans, shorts, or tennis shoes). Boys – khaki or dress pants, collared shirt. Girls – nice slacks or dress code length skirts or dresses. An offering will be received to help support our music program expenses. PTM Officers will also be elected.

DRESS CODE REMINDERS

All clothing should be modest and appropriate for our Christian school setting and should promote a safe and effective learning environment. At all times personal decency, dignity, self-respect and respect for others should dictate student dress. The school dress code prohibits appearance or clothing that (1) is substantially disruptive, (2) is provocative, revealing, vulgar or obscene or (3) endangers the health or safety of the student or others.

- No head apparel (hats, hoodies, headbands, scarves, bandanas, picks, combs, etc.) or sunglasses may be worn inside the building;
- No visible undergarments;
- No holes in pants above the knee;
- No halter tops, tank tops, racer backs, or spaghetti straps (no bare shoulders);
- No clothing that exposes midriff or cleavage;
- No pants that are baggy or drag the floor (pants/shorts must be worn around the waist);
- No short shorts or excessively short dresses/skirts (shorts and skirts may fall no shorter than 5 inches above the knee;

- No spandex or other very tight clothing (this includes leggings, jeggings, yoga pants, etc.) unless worn with a longer shirt or dress/skirt;
- No sleepwear or bedroom slippers;
- No bare feet:
- No clothing that contains advertisements for tobacco, alcohol, or drugs; pictures or graphics of nudity; words that are profane, lewd, vulgar, or indecent or likely to be disruptive to the learning environment;
- No items that are potentially dangerous such as fish hooks, chains, or spiked objects.

Should students choose to dye or color their hair, hair colors must be a naturally occurring hair color. Hairstyles must not mimic ungodly cultural icons.

Flip-flops are not allowed for K-5 and sandals must have a fitted strap around the heel for safety reasons. Sandals or sandal-like flip-flops may be worn by middle/high school students. No shoes with games or wheels are permitted.

EARLY REGISTRATION 2019-2020

Registration is now open for next school year! Below is a chart showing the multi-child discounts and the option of a 12-month payment plan. The 12-month plan must begin in June unless a catch-up payment is made in August covering June and July. Registration is \$75 if paid by the last day of school, \$120 if paid between June 1 - July 15, and \$150 after July 15. The book fee is \$200.
