DRESS CODE

The board made some dress code changes for this year that were sent out June 22. The following is a paragraph from that letter:

At its June 13th meeting the Christian Education Center Board took a careful look at the academy dress code at the request of me and the teachers. Changing styles over the past couple of years had made enforcing the dress code fairly, as it was written, increasingly difficult. Suggestions were made by the teachers which were further refined by the board. The new dress code that will appear in the 2016-17 Parent/Student Handbook is enclosed or attached by email. Please read it carefully and purchase accordingly. In fairness to everyone, it will be carefully enforced.

If you did not pay careful attention to the changes then, please go to the Parent/Student Handbook and review the details there. Students will be notified but not penalized this week if they are not in dress code. Beginning next week students will be removed from class and parents called to bring items that do meet the code. Thank you in advance for your cooperation.

STUDENT FILE DOCUMENTS

Each student should have a **current copy** of the <u>enrollment</u> and <u>financial agreements</u> in their file. New students received one in their packet. Returning students received one at orientation or the first day of school. If you have not already done so, please read and sign these documents and return them to your child's teacher for your child's file, as well as an updated <u>Family Information Sheet</u> for office use. Please be sure to include all contact numbers. Only primary contact #'s will be used for the Student Directory. We also need the signed back sheet of the Parent/Student Handbook. Thank you for providing this important information in a timely manner.

LUNCH VOLUNTEERS

We are currently looking for volunteers to help our youngest elementary students (K-3) with lunches. It may require warming a dinner in the microwave or opening a child's milk or juice box and wiping tables. This helps our teachers by making their lunch time less rushed and more enjoyable.
