



## NEIL GOSLEN NEIGHBORS GROVE SCHOLARSHIP FUNDAY – THIS SATURDAY

Please plan to volunteer with our **huge** scholarship fundraiser. Many, many volunteers will be needed to help with carnival games, food preparation and serving (hot dogs), general supervision, "gophers," and more. Parents, nearly a fourth of our students are here because of assistance from scholarship funds. Without these students our school program would suffer significantly and those children would not have the opportunity of a Christ-centered education. The Neil Goslen Neighbors Grove Scholarship Fund was established in 2004 in memory of Ben & Julie Goslen's son, Neil, who was a rising 1st grader at Neighbors Grove when the Lord called him home. The Goslen family gave endless hours and tireless energy each year for 7 years to organize the Neil Goslen Neighbors Grove Open golf tournament and silent auction to fund the scholarship program. Scholarships are awarded based on documented financial need. These scholarships have made it possible for many children to receive a Christian education that otherwise could not have. The NGNGO averaged raising almost \$15,000 a year over the 7 years totaling about \$100,000. The academy family has now received the fundraising leadership "baton" from the Goslens and is continuing to raise funds for scholarships. The Goslens also continue to be very involved in raising scholarship funds though their other son is now in college. This fundraiser is very important to the life of our school.
