#### NGCA SCHOLARSHIP ASSISTANCE FOR 2017-18

NGCA scholarship funds are awarded based on financial need. This financial assistance must be requested and applied for **each year**. These limited funds are for families whose children could not attend without assistance. If you will need assistance for your child or children to attend NGCA next school year, it is time to apply. The letter describing the source of these funds and the documents required to apply is posted on the website or you may pick up a copy in the office. Full participation in the GAP Fund is mandatory for scholarship recipients and is a primary guideline used to award future scholarships.

#### SUMMER TUTORING AVAILABLE

The summer months provide an opportunity for students to focus on individual areas of extra challenge, without the stress and fatigue of daily schoolwork. This is also a time when lack of practice sometimes makes the transition back to class in the Fall more difficult.

With this in mind, private tutoring will be offered with Miss Howell from June 5-August 18, 2017. The content of the individualized one-hour sessions will be tailored to the specific needs of the student in areas of Language Arts at all grade levels, including phonetic reading and spelling, reading comprehension, creative writing, grammar, and language mechanics. Elementary math instruction in the four basic operations, including counting, place value, borrowing, carrying, counting money, telling time, and fact mastery drills will also be available.

Both morning and afternoon times will be available for twice-weekly sessions on Mondays and Wednesdays, and schedules can be adjusted to accommodate vacations. (For students enrolled in Summer Camp, those paying for tutoring will have their sessions during their time on campus.) Cost will be \$20 per hour, payable directly to Miss Howell and due in advance on Wednesday for the following week. ### 2017-18 REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Registration is open for next school year! There is a small increase in tuition for next year. Below is a chart showing the multi-child discounts and the option of a 12-month payment plan. The 12-month plan must begin in June unless a catch-up payment is made in August covering June and July. Registration is \$120; however, it is \$75 if paid by the last day of school. The book fee is \$190. There is also a referral incentive: if a family indicates on their enrollment form that you referred them to NGCA, then you and the new family will receive a \$100 credit towards tuition on their second month of attendance. A "referral" means that they would not have seriously considered coming without your recommendation and encouragement. Please get the word out that NGCA is a great place to be! Thank you!
